MEETING PLACE

Walker Field Airport (GJT)
Baggage Claim

You will be required to take extra precautions while traveling including wearing personal protective equipment like a mask and goggles for your safety and the safety of your future crew. Closer to course start you will receive specific COVID-19 travel safety protocol.

COURSE START:

Please meet your Instructor and crew at Baggage Claim of the airport no later than **1:00pm** on the first day of the course. We will do a roll call to ensure all participants are located. Parents will be notified **only** if a student does not arrive as expected. Participants not fully approved by their Course Advisor will not be allowed on the bus. The bus will leave promptly. Do not miss the bus as there is no other way to the course start.

COURSE END:

The bus is scheduled to arrive at the Walker Field/Grand Junction Airport (GJT) by **11:00 AM**. **We cannot guarantee that you will be able to make a flight out before 12:00 PM (noon), so plan accordingly.**

TRAVEL PROBLEMS:

If you encounter travel problems which will delay your arrival to Grand Junction, we can help troubleshoot solutions so that you can get to your course start. Call us at (720) 381-6589 and press option #2 (emergencies) and continue to follow the directions for a travel emergency on a Utah course. Make certain to **leave your name, course, and call-back number** if you are leaving a voicemail.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

If you need to arrive the day before the course start and/or spend the last night in Grand Junction, we recommend you contact the CLARION INN *directly* to make reservations. In order to redeem the Outward Bound discounted rate, you must identify yourself as a student when making reservations. The hotel also offers the following: free shuttle to and from the airport, indoor pool, hot tub, exercise room, restaurant, free wi-fi, and in-room movies. **Please make reservations 45 days in advance or ASAP.**
