



Travel Insurance

We think travel insurance is a great investment. If you are forced to cancel your trip before it begins or have to leave course due to a sickness, injury, or personal emergency the Colorado Outward Bound School will not be able to give you a refund for your tuition. Investing in travel insurance allows you to protect the investment you have made.

Travel protection products differ from company to company and from policy to policy, but they can often reimburse both travel costs and full or partial tuition costs in the event of medical emergencies. There are many companies that offer travel protection, but we've seen success with Travelex Insurance. Of course, there are other options and you should make sure to research your decision carefully.

With travel insurance, some coverages go away (such as the ability to cover against loss due to pre-existing medical conditions) if you are a certain amount of time away from having made your first payment on the trip. For this reason, we recommend researching early (within 10 days of deposit) to have the most options available. If you/your child will be climbing with technical equipment during the trip, you should consider the Travelex Travel Select policy with the Adventure Sports upgrade.

Do note: if you have a pre-existing medical condition or may want to purchase a Cancel For Any Reason policy, you must purchase the trip insurance within 21 days of initial trip deposit/payment.

Depending on the trip insurance company, you must be a US resident to purchase trip insurance. Please note rates can be very state specific and each state has their own set of policy rules.
